Gene analysis future of med cure: Expert

Lucknow: Prescribing medicine after gene analysis of patients suffering from chronic diseases like cancer, kidney and bone issues would be the future process of treatment in India as it will be precise and effective.

This was said by Sanjeev Mishra, Vice-Chancellor, Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, at the third International Conference on Personalized Medicine ISPM CON-2023 organized at Era University on Sunday. He said, "Developed nations have already started gene level lab research for better management of diseases. We also need to adopt this modal." By doing this both patients and doctors will be benefited because patients will get better treatment, while doctors will learn which medicines are more effective according to genotypes, he added.

V-C of Era University Prof Abbas Mahdi said that "during Covid times we got 80% recovery which was highest in UP."
