## ISPMCON-2023: Experts outline need for ensuring patient-centric research

LUCKNOW: A three-day conference on personalised medicine titled 'Redefining the Future of Medicine' concluded at the Era University on Sunday with experts outlining the need for ensuring patient-centric research.
