

Objective

The primary aim of the IQAC is:

- Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive
 to quality education and faculty development to adopt the required
 knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning
 process;
- Collection and analysis of feedback from all the stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes; d) Dissemination of information on various quality parameters to all the stakeholders;
- Organization of intra- and inter-institutional workshops and seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;
- Documentation of various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement;
- Acting as a nodal agency of the institution for coordinating qualityrelated activities, including adoption and dissemination of the best practices;
- Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining and enhancing institutional quality;
- Periodical conduct of Academic and Administrative Audits along with their followup activities; and
- Preparation and submission of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per the guidelines and parameters of NAAC.



Organisation & Implementation

The operation principle behind the IQAS is implementation of quality standards and development of continuous feedback system in accordance with DMAIC principle. DMAIC is a data-driven process-improvement methodology that focuses on properly identifying the problem, utilizing data to determine the root cause, developing and implementing the solution, and verifying that the solution continues to be effective over time.
